An HR Meet Up is an informal gathering, hosted by members in their own city or town. HR Meet Ups will be posted on the CPHR BC & Yukon calendar/website and registration will be through the website. Both Members and Non-Members are encouraged to attend. These are informal gatherings where those attending will bring or pay for their own food and beverages.

Choosing a location - Community Ambassador's choose the location - book it and manage it. Your Meet Up must be a place of business - these may not be held in a member's home. Some good spots would be a community boardroom, or a coffee shop that allows people to "hold" a large community table. It depends how much privacy you want for your meet up conversations, the number of attendees etc. Alternately, it could be a fun event like bocce ball at a park.

How many Community Ambassadors are needed in a location? In a best case scenario we would have two Ambassadors.

Is there a fee? No registration fee, no funds provided from CPHR BC & Yukon – this is super informal – attendees pay on their own if needed.

How many Meet Ups will be scheduled in a year? We recommend working with your MRM - or designate to choose a maximum of 4 dates over a calendar year - in advance, so that people in your area know what and when to expect things to happen.

Will CPD hours be earned? No

Registration – will be through the CPHR BC & Yukon website and a registration list will be provided 24 hours in advance to the Community Ambassador(s).

HR Meet Up Interest Lists – CPHR BC & Yukon will create interest lists that members can add themselves to in their member profile when they are logged in.Non-members may also add themselves when they create a profile in our database.
